### ○ Characteristics and history

In October 2005, three Toyama University, Toyama Medical and Pharmaceutical University and Takaoka National College were integrated to form the present University of Toyama.

As of May 2019, there were about 9,100 students. Academic exchange agreements have been drawn up with 135 institutions in 30 countries. We are eager to welcome international students, and our Organization for International Education and Exchange plays a key role in enabling us to do so.

I. Intensive Japanese program for Monbukagakusho: Scholarship students at Organization for International Education and Exchange  
Period: October 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021

Period: April to September, October to March

Class: 3 grades (Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced)
