In October 2005, three Toyama University, Toyama Medical and Pharmaceutical University and Takaoka National College were integrated to form the present University of Toyama.

As of May 2022, there were about 9,000 students. Academic exchange agreements have been drawn up with 141 institutions in 32 countries and regions. I. Intensive Japanese program for Monbukagakusho: Scholarship students at Organization for International Education and Exchange

Period: October 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024

II. Supplementary course: Students can take supplementary courses depending to their ability.

Period: April to September, October to March

Class: 3 grades (Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced)

- Specialized training

Period: April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025

An academic adviser and, if necessary, the related professors advise the student on his/her research. (No subjects or courses are taught in English) It is possible to have a one and a half year course depending on your Japanese ability.
