

Asahi Foundation for International Education Scholarship 2026

This is to announce that the application period for Asahi Foundation for International Education Scholarship has started as follows:

- 1.Application Information: Refer to “Application guidelines”.
- 2.Scholarship Period: From April 2026 until March 2027 (**45,000** yen per month)
- 3.Submit To:
 - Gofuku campus:** International Affairs Division (General Education Bldg.B 1F)
 - Sugitani campus:** Student and Academic Affairs Division
(Medicine and Pharmaceutical Library2F)
 - Takaoka campus:** Art and Design General Affairs and Educational Affairs Division (Bldg.A 1F)
- 4.Application Period: **Thursday, April 23 - before 15:00 Thursday, April 30[Strict deadline]**
- 5.Number of Nominees: 25 students (ASEAN students will be preferentially selected as nominees.)
- 6.Eligibility
 - (1)For all students
 - (a) Privately financed international students who are enrolled in University of Toyama as a degree student and have “Student (留学)” residence status as of April 2026.
(Excluding 1st year undergraduate students)
 - (b) Other than the above, refer to Application guidelines. Students who are going to graduate in September 2026 are not eligible to apply.
 - (2)For ASEAN (including Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Vietnam, and Myanmar) students
 - (a) Students who are a recipient of other scholarships (excluding MEXT and government sponsored scholarships) this year are allowed to apply for this scholarship regardless of the amount you receive, provided that the foundations (ex. Gakushushoreihi) accept double scholarships. Be sure to confirm it at International Affairs Division.
You can apply even if you were once the recipient of this scholarship.
 - (3)For non- ASEAN students
 - (a) Students who are a recipient of other scholarship this year are allowed to apply for this scholarship, provided that the foundations accept double scholarships and the scholarship amount does not exceed 30,000 yen. Be sure to confirm it at International Affairs Division. Students who have previously received this scholarship are less likely to be selected.
- 7.Application Documents:
 - <All students> Documents described in Application guidelines 5 (2)
(**including essay and health certificate**)
Photocopy of Residence Card (two-sided)
 - <Non- ASEAN students only>
Application form for University and its attachments
(such as receipt of rent and withholding slip)
- (※1) The essay, one of the requirements described in Application guidelines 5 (2), can be written in Japanese or in English. Japanese essay should be handwritten (not typed) with a black ink pen or a black ballpoint pen. English essay should be typed (not handwritten). However, application form should be handwritten.
- (※2) **Do not copy other applicants' essays. If the content or format is clearly similar, the likelihood of being selected decreases.**
