III Social contribution:

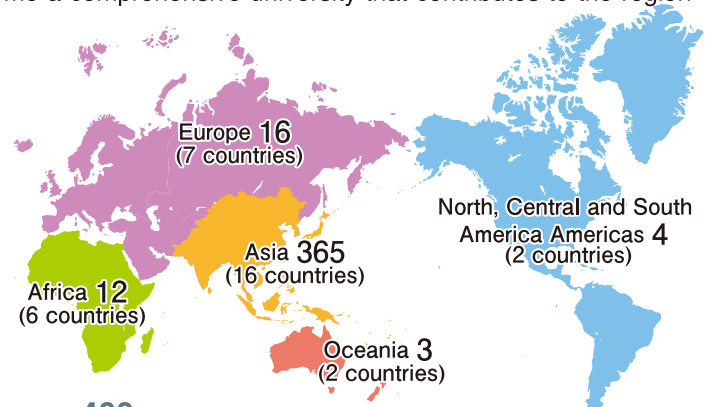
contributing to the region and the international community

In order to actively promote education, research, and community service, the University of Toyama aims to become a university with a high degree of transparency that is open to society.



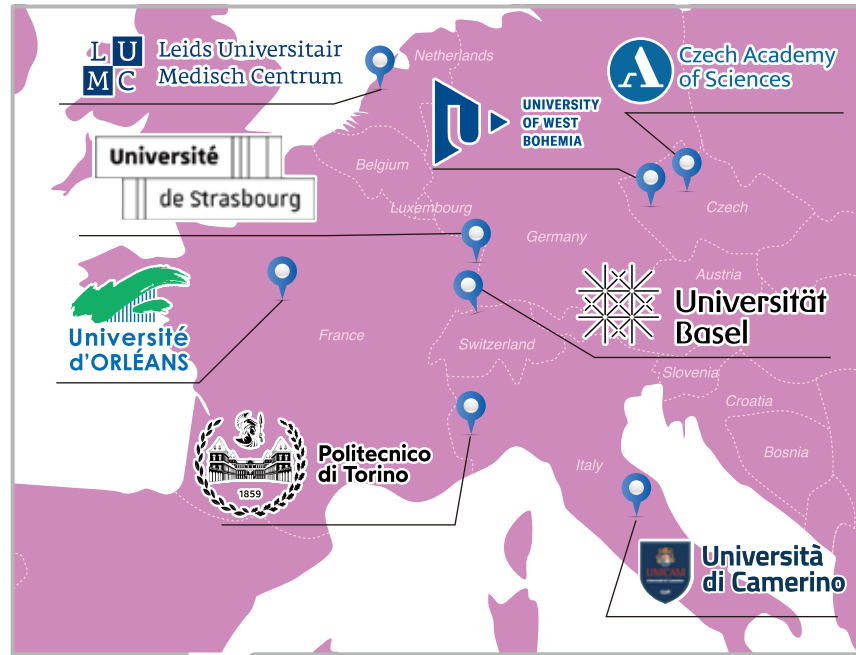

Exemption and Deferment for Admission and Tuition Fees (for Graduate Students)

Regular graduate students (except government-sponsored foreign students) with excellent academic records who are experiencing financial difficulties are eligible to apply for an exemption from the admission and tuition fees. Applicants who pass the screening will be granted a full- or half-exemption from or deferment of the fees.

Scholarships



There are scholarships offered by private foundations and other organizations. Eligibility requirements and application periods vary depending on the scholarship. When it is open, announcements will be posted on the university bulletin board and website.

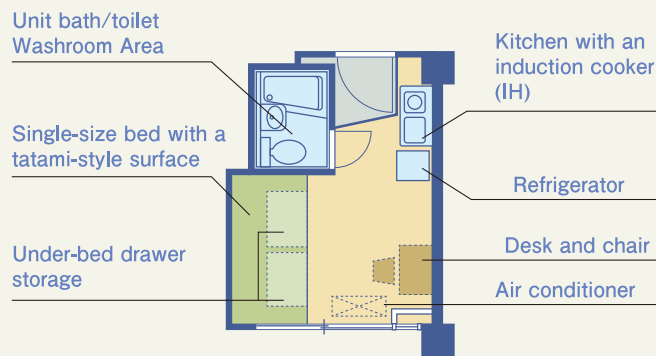
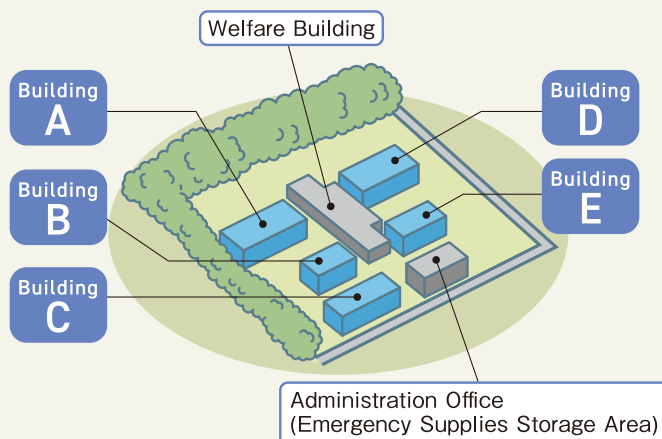
University of Toyama Student Dormitory “Shinju-Ryou”

Shinju-Ryou is located in a quiet, green area halfway between the Gofuku Campus and the Sugitani Campus.

Starting life in a new and unfamiliar place can feel uncertain, but at Shinju-Ryou, the caretaker is here to support you from the moment you move in.

Sample Room: Comfortable 13 m² Single Room

The room is designed like a studio apartment and comes fully furnished with essential furniture and appliances for single living.

※Buildings A, B, and C are for male students, while Buildings D and E are for female students.

※In addition, utility fees such as water, electricity, and gas are not included in the dormitory fee and will be charged separately.

Shared Facilities : The welfare building serves as a common area for all residents and includes the following amenities:

- Mailboxes for each dormitory building
- Coin-operated laundry machines and dryers
- Vending machines for food and beverages

These facilities are provided to support residents' daily life in a convenient and comfortable environment.

Resident Support and Emergency Preparedness (Administration office) :

A caretaker is on duty at the administration building from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM to assist residents with any questions or concerns.

The administration office building also contains a storage area for emergency supplies, including food, beverages, and essential items for disaster preparedness, such as flashlights, blankets, and first-aid kits.

These supplies are regularly checked and maintained to ensure residents' safety and support in the event of a disaster.

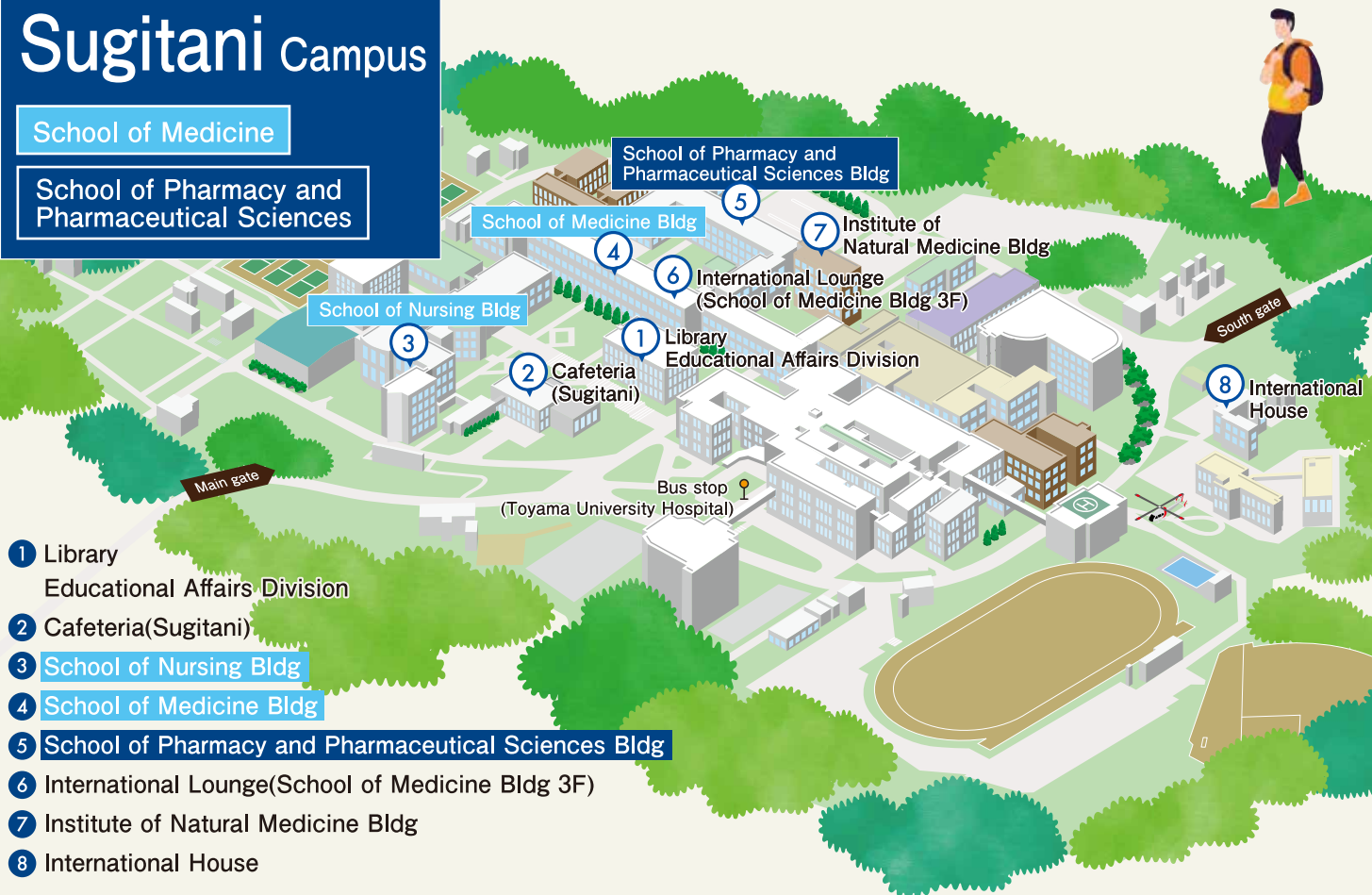

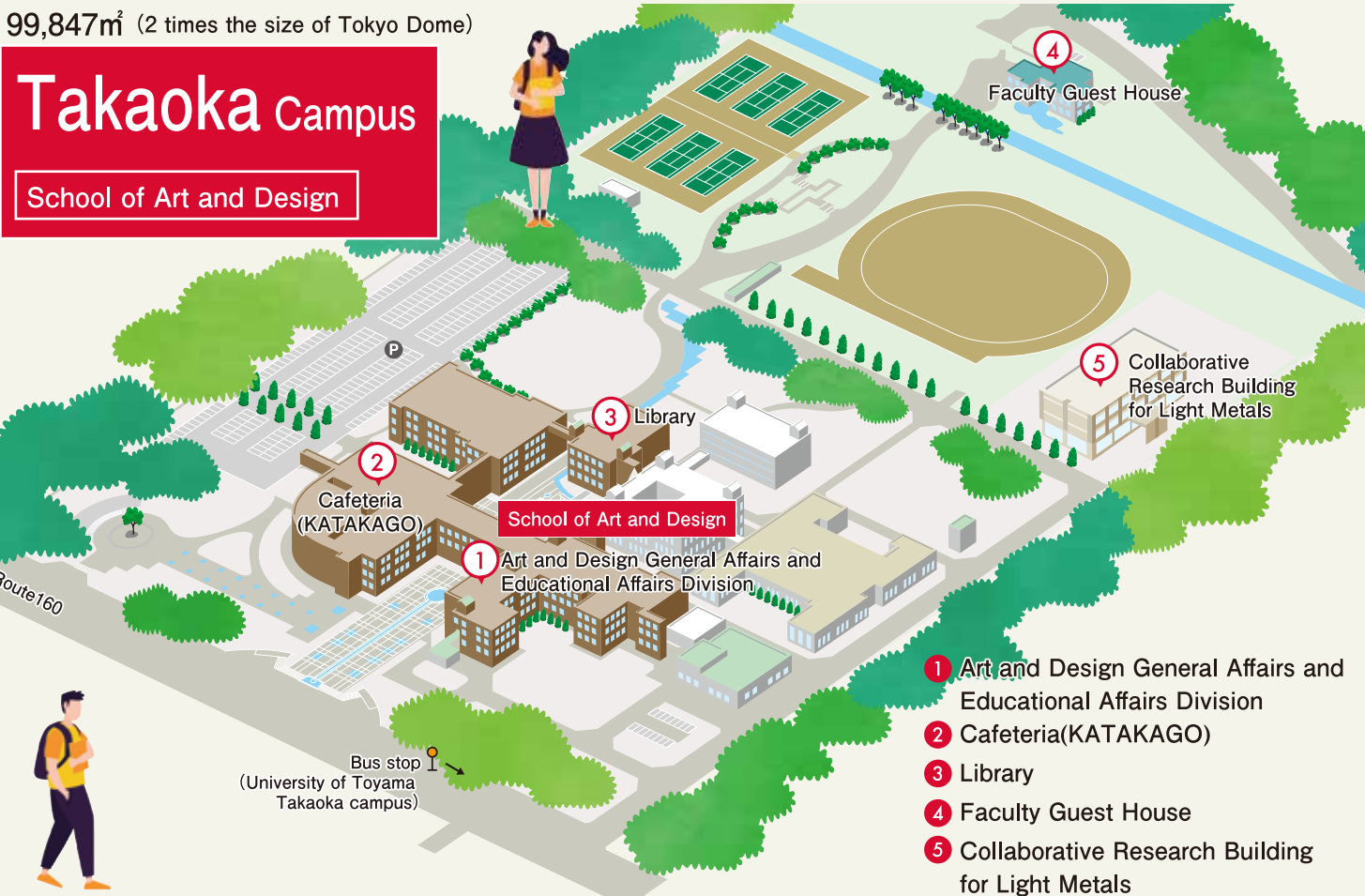

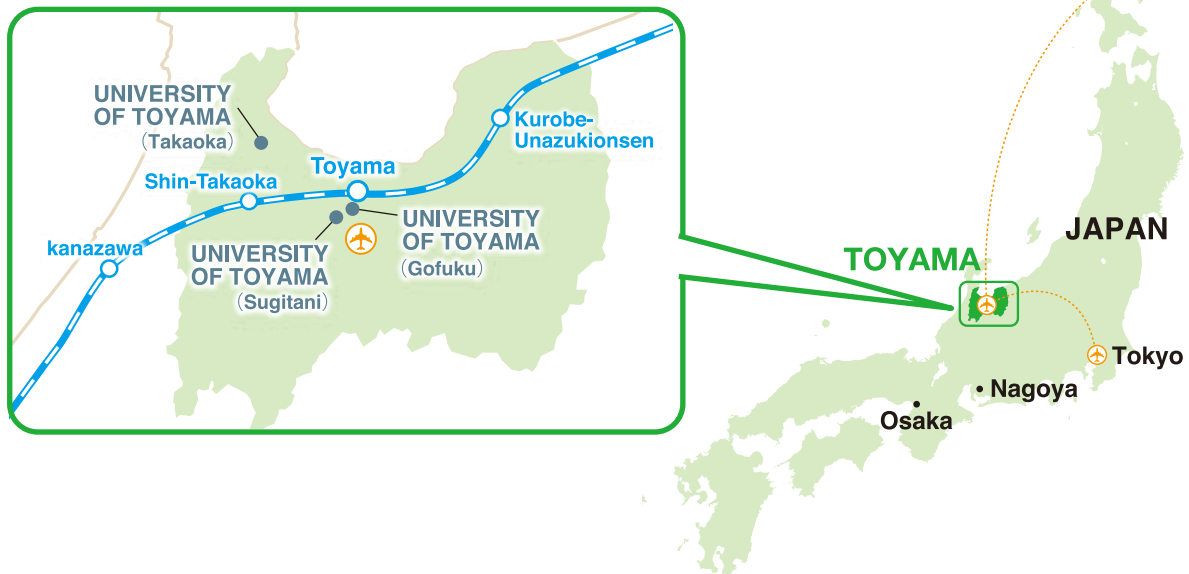

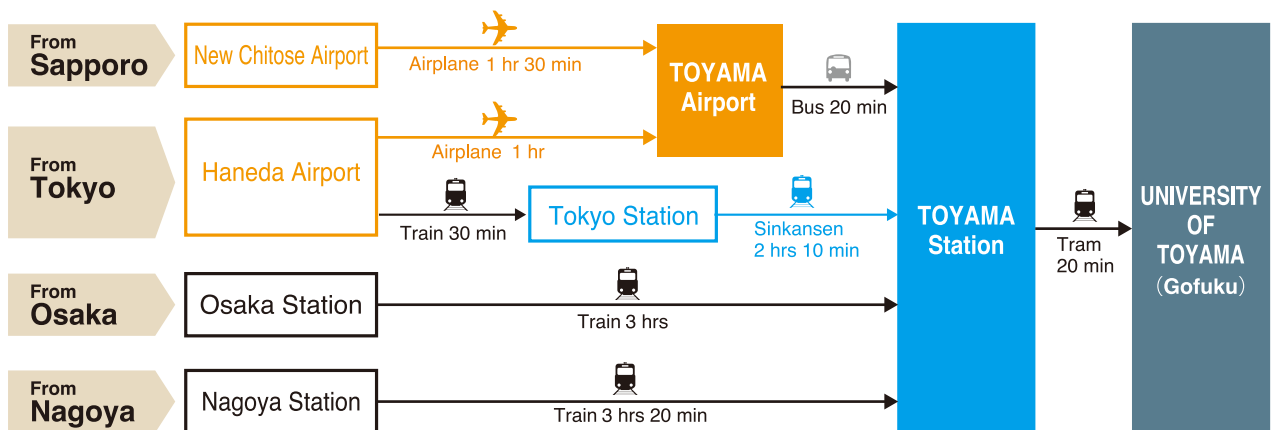
