1. Number of Positions

One Specially Appointed Assistant Professor (Term: From the date of appointment until March 31, 2028)

2. Field of Expertise

Microbiology, Infectious Diseases, and Immunology

3. Qualifications

- ① Holds a doctoral degree in a science-related field (including those expected to obtain the degree by the time of appointment) and has at least one first-author paper published in a peer-reviewed journal.
- ② Has research achievements in the relevant field and is capable of assisting in education and research supervision at both the master's and doctoral levels.
- ③ Demonstrates willingness to secure external funding such as Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research.
- ④ Can actively contribute to university-wide activities, regional engagement, and the development of future researchers.
- ⑤ Able to deliver lectures in English.
- ⑥ Can contribute to liberal arts education.
- ⑦ Can participate in entrance examination-related duties.
- ⑧ Since animal experiments will be conducted, the applicant must confirm that there are no physical allergies or other conditions that would hinder research activities involving animals (prior experience in handling animals is acceptable).

As soon as possible on or after February 1, 2026.

The successful candidate will primarily engage in supporting rapid drug development for infectious diseases, developing analytical platforms, and contributing to education in microbiology and infectious diseases.

Desired Qualities:

1. Willingness to acquire skills and knowledge in infectious disease research and single-cell transcriptomics analysis (including those with no prior experience).
2. Ability or intention to independently design research projects.
3. Commitment to following laboratory agreements, respecting others, and maintaining effective communication.
4. Effort to apply personal knowledge and skills to collaborative research projects.
5. Awareness of the importance of reporting, communication, and consultation regarding laboratory matters.
6. Ability to conduct animal experiments, and preferably experience in at least one of the following areas:
 - a) Microbiology b) Immunology c) Genomics d) Proteomics e) Molecular Biology
 - f) Cell Biology g) Bioinformatics h) Research experience in pharmaceutical

or other industries i) Various microscopy analyses j) Development of analytical platforms k) Clinical practice experience
